Obama Administration Launches Sales Pitch On Climate Pledge

White House sees leadership role in bringing countries to table in Paris talks.

March 31, 2015 -- Now that the U.S. has officially affirmed its international pledge to combat climate change by slashing carbon dioxide emissions by up to 28 percent by 2025, the White House is looking to the next step -- getting everyone else on board.

While the pledge itself is about domestic emissions, U.S. officials know that a global deal is toothless without other governments on board, and so the rhetoric has turned abroad.

And Obama has made climate change one of the centerpieces of both his domestic and foreign policy in his second term -- helping to bring about a final agreement at the United Nations talks in Paris later this year would be a monumental caper. Getting international participation is also crucial to selling the the climate plan at home.

The White House hasn't been shy about heaping attention on governments who sign on, and its own role in getting them on board.

When Mexico last Friday announced its pledge to peak carbon emissions by 2026, the White House came out with a statement commending the country for setting an "example for the rest of the world," along with a separate joint statement reaffirming a commitment to "jointly addressing climate in their integrated economy."

Most major countries -- including major emitters like China and India -- hadn't yet filed official climate plans. Negotiators aren't sweating the rollout since countries accounting for more than 50 percent of global emissions have made public commitments, but the White House says it's going to keep working with countries until the ink is dry on a deal.

"I wouldn't say that we're twisting arms, but we are reaching out to a variety of countries to talk about the importance of submitting timely and ambitious" climate pledges, said Todd Stern, the State Department special envoy for climate change. "We want to encourage as ambitious a set of targets as we can possibly get ... but part and parcel of that is we want broad participation."

Stern said the administration has been offering technical support to countries working on Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDC), the formal term for the climate commitments. That builds on bilateral talks with countries like China, where both countries committed to long-term emission cuts, and India, where Obama said he had reached a "personal commitment" with Indian prime minister Narendra Modi on the UN talks.

Congressional Republicans have long belittled environmental rules as costing too much at home and doing too little when other countries aren't acting. Even the U.S.-China agreement in November didn't blunt the criticism, with Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell calling it "unrealistic" and saying it "requires the Chinese to do nothing at all for 16 years" while the U.S. imposed costly climate regulations.

When countries unveil their plans for curbing carbon over the coming decade, the climate-conscious world knows that it wants to see aggressive, economywide cuts from the United States. Similarly, consensus is building that China, which now emits more carbon dioxide than any other country, should announce a peak year after which its emissions will fall.

But what of India, the globe's fourth-largest climate polluter and yet also home to more than 400 million people who live on less than \$1.25 per day and lack access to basic energy services?

The question is a pressing one in the wake of Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's first Washington, D.C., visit, during which climate change featured prominently on his agenda with President Obama. While Modi has vowed to work with the United States toward a new global climate deal in 2015, the government has been playing its negotiating cards close to the vest. Meanwhile, others have been mum on precisely what they hope to see India contribute to that agreement.

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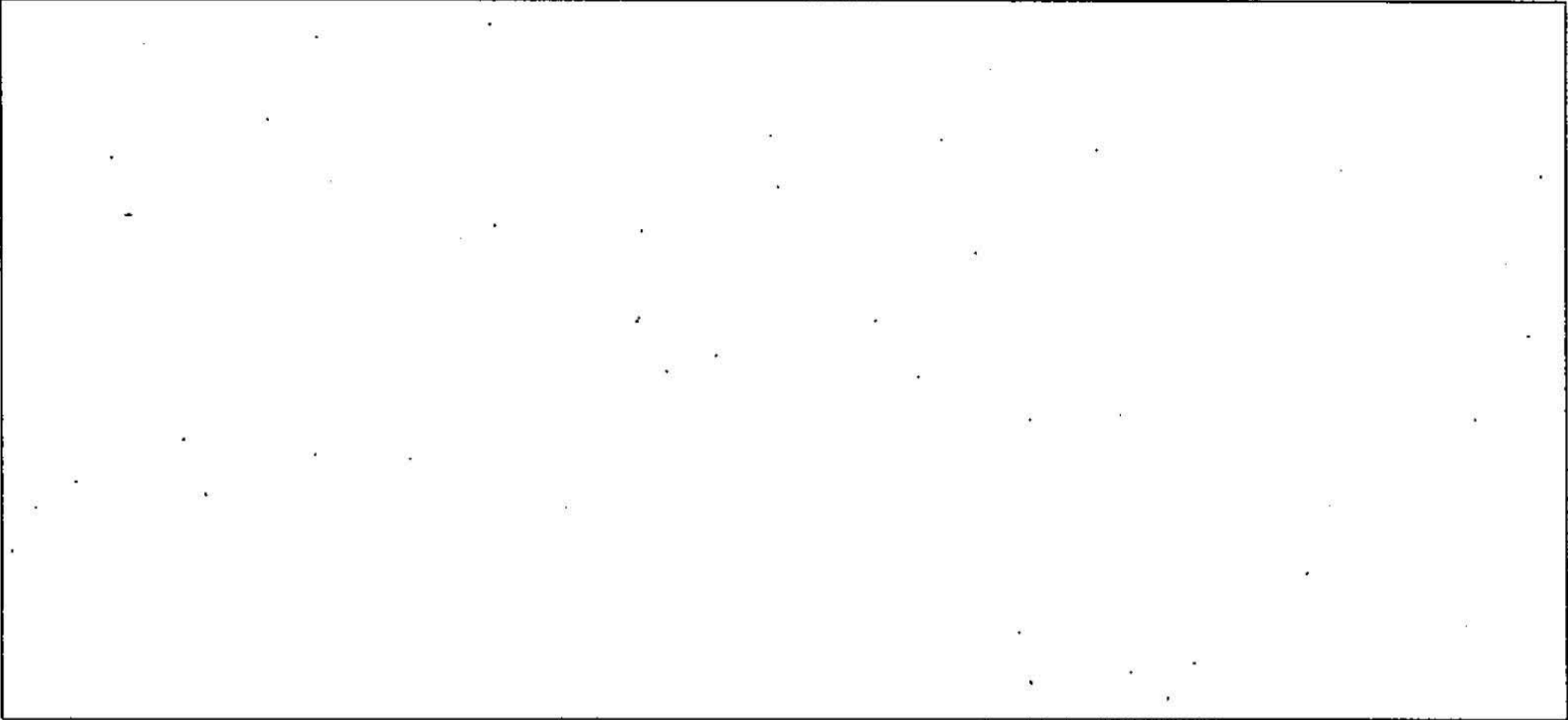

Key points:

- Carlos agrees that my value add is talking about Paris and implications thereof. I could deliver a short opening or can arrange with Carlos to pose question or questions that elicit the same kind of answer. Latter is much better as a matter of preparation (less) and performance art (better because look at and connect more effectively with audience).
- I said to him that kind of thing I'd instinctively talk about, and that I have value added as compared to others in Houston, is: what's going on in the Paris negotiation, where are the battle lines, what's likely to happen, what path will a Paris result inexorably put us on, what implications will this have for the development of lower/low carbon energy, for the hastening of the transition to such energy here and worldwide, etc.
- Carlos comment: the structure of the agreement you're trying to conclude is different from anything that the UNFCCC has tried to negotiate before. Traditionally, the best was always the enemy of the good. Now you're not allowing that to happen (he's referring her to the nationally determined structure), you're asking how do we get movement and how do we get going. He also said it would be interesting to people to understand the political (diplomatic) dynamic as between various countries/regions. And ultimately you get to the question of whether this all is good for business.
- He noted that gas is obviously an important transitional fuel and noted the importance of gas becoming competitive with coal in places like Asia.
- He also noted that there will be a lot of power guys there like GE, AES, etc.
- He noted utility in making point that acting now, taking action where we can as effectively as we can will allow us to not have to come down in emissions as steeply down the road, and will be more protective of GDP globally.
- He noted that an issue for governments around the world involves what kind of policy framework they need to put in place with regard to prices, taxes, the cost of financing, etc. so that you influence the calculation between whether the economic numbers add up better for the geothermal plant in Indonesia (or wherever) as compared to the coal plant.

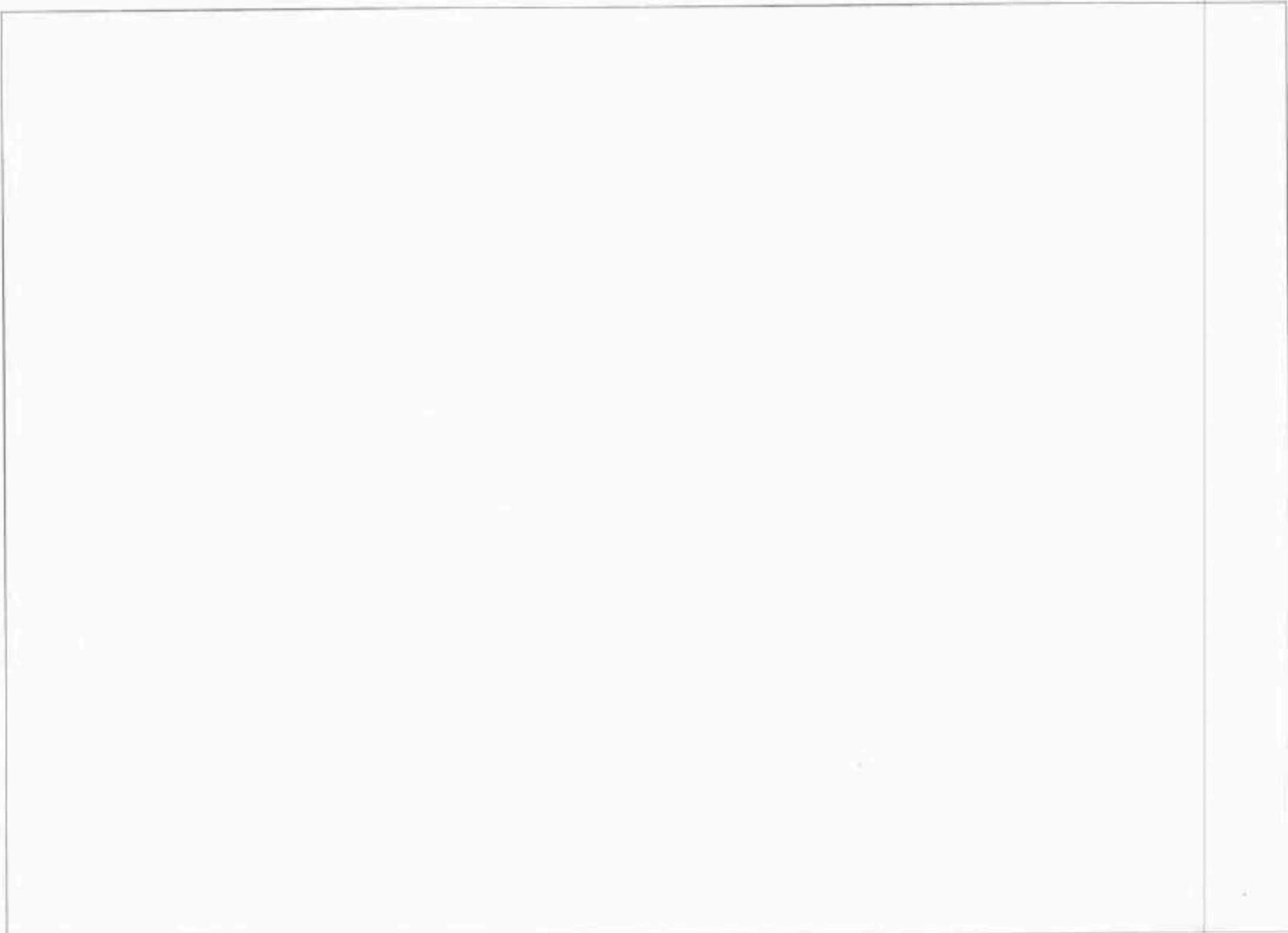

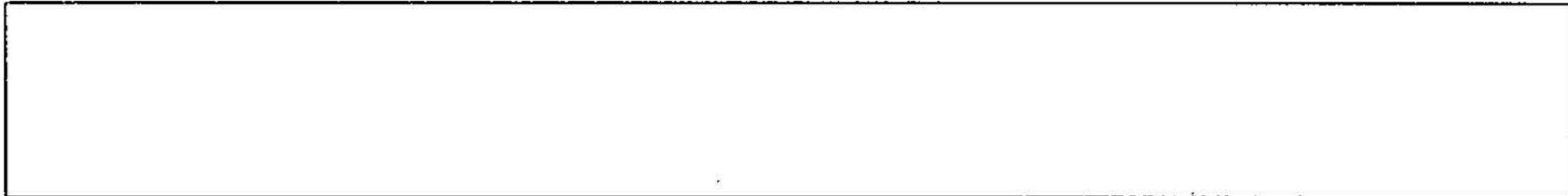

SECRETARY KERRY: Good afternoon, everybody. It's my distinct pleasure to welcome His Excellency, the foreign minister of China, Foreign Minister Wang Yi. I met with the foreign minister in July in Beijing for a very productive Strategic & Economic Dialogue. We spent two days together and President Xi opened up that meeting and closed the meeting. And we are very grateful for China's significant commitment to that dialogue. And in addition, we had useful conversations in August during my trip to Burma for the ASEAN Regional Forum, and we had a chance to briefly talk in New York. Knowing that we were going to be meeting here, we held back on the length and breadth of that conversation.

But I'm very pleased that he has taken time to visit us here in Washington on the occasion of China's National Day, and we congratulate you on that and welcome you here. And I'm pleased he's taken time to come here and strengthen our relationship as part of the ongoing dialogue between us.

I want to emphasize that the United States welcomes the rise of a peaceful, prosperous, and stable China, and one that plays a responsible role in Asia and the world, and contributes to upholding the existing rules and the norms on economic and security issues. I take note that China is stepping up and contributing to this challenge of Ebola, and we are appreciative for China's willingness to put both equipment and personnel on the line in order to help deal with this. We view that in very positive terms with respect to China's important role in global leadership.

And that is why we are committed – that role and our interests together – in trying to find ways to cooperate on those issues of greatest consequence on a global basis while we manage some of the differences between us effectively. We want to show a new model of relations in which we broaden our cooperation on the common interests and constructively manage those differences so that we can be as effective as possible.

The foreign minister and I are both coming off of a very busy and very productive week in New York for the climate summit and the UN General Assembly. There I took pleasure in participating in President Obama's meeting with Chinese Vice Premier Zhang Gaoli and I left those meetings encouraged, significantly.
