Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 706, 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1), and Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 15(a), the Competitive Enterprise Institute, Anthony Kreucher, Walter M. Kreucher, James Leedy, Marc Scribner and the Domestic Energy Producers Alliance hereby petition this Court for review of the final rule of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) titled *Revised* 2023 and Later Model Year Light-Duty Vehicle Greenhouse Gas Emissions Standards, 86 FR 74434 (Dec. 30, 2021). Petitioners attach the final rule as Exhibit A to this Petition. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 7607(b)(1).

EPA's final rule attempts to establish stringent fleet-wide automobile emission standards with credit trading and enhanced credits for electric vehicles, but the agency lacks the legal authority to issue such a rule.
